Project Case Study

This contract was for the upgrading and refurbishment of the existing timber building at Northamptonshire County Cricket Club formerly used as a bowls pavilion.

The new scheme provided a Study Centre for general use, mainly for children.

The works consisted of full internal refurbishment upgrading the plumbing, heating and electrical installations, new floor finishes and redecorations.

The whole of the roof was repaired and completely recovered using a high performance single ply membrane

The building was also adapted and upgraded to provide disabled facilities and access.

The Steele & Bray team created an attractive facility from an old building that was in great need of repair.
